Official Rules & Regulations

- 1) ENTRY PERIOD: The Contest begins at 10:00am on July 1, 2024 and ends at 11:59pm on July 12, 2024.
- **2) ELIGIBILITY**: You must be thirteen (13) years or older and a legal resident in the province of British Columbia (BC) to enter this Contest. City of Surrey employees and immediate family members of City of Surrey employees are not eligible to enter.
- **3) HOW TO ENTER**: Between July 1, 2024 and July 12, 2024, complete the Surrey Canada Day exit survey that will be distributed via our Surrey BC Events and Surrey Canada Day media channels. You may enter a maximum of one (1) time by fully completing the survey.

4) ENTRY GUIDELINES:

The survey must be completed in full. Previously published material for which non-exclusive rights were granted may be entered as long as you still maintain the right to grant us a license. Late or corrupt entries will not be accepted.

Your entries must not be obscene or otherwise inappropriate, as determined by the City of Surrey in its sole discretion. Entries that are deemed inappropriate will not be accepted. You are responsible for obtaining, prior to submitting any entry, any releases and consents necessary to permit the exhibition and use of the entry in the manner described in these Official Rules without additional compensation.

5) PRIZES: There is one (1) Grand Prize consisting of a \$200 Guildford Town Centre gift card.

The Prize must be accepted as awarded and is non-transferable. No substitution of the Prize is permitted. The Prize cannot be returned for a cash refund.
